

GUIDE FOR SORTING

NLP WOODEN PALLET/EURO PALLET (TP)



The following criteria are the basis for the sorting of NLP WOODEN PALLET/ EURO-PALLET (TP/EUR)



NLP quality (approved pallets)

Sorted pallets must be in such a shape and condition that it can be reused in the supply chain between customers.

- ✓ The blocks facing out must be clearly marked **EUR** or **EPAL** with a ring around them. A total of 6 stamps on a pallet.
- ✓ No damages or missing parts.
- ✓ Dry and free of smell, no oil spill, food etc.
- ✓ Colour shade can be light or dark.

If required, heat-treated Euro-pallet:

- ✓ A heat-treated Euro-pallet must also have the following stamp on the long side of the middle block:



Return for repair (not approved pallets)

Sorted pallets must be in such a condition that they **cannot** be used as load carriers further in a flow of goods.

- ✓ The EUR/EPAL stamp is missing on one or more blocks.
- ✓ Blocks/boards have cracks, are split or plain missing.
- ✓ Nails showing or sticking out.
- ✓ The pallet smells, is soiled, or otherwise unclean or contaminated.
- ✓ Important with common sense: Return pallets to NLP that you wouldn't want to put your own products on.

Before sorting:

When sorting NLP wooden pallets, all foreign elements must be removed; such as cardboard, plastic, interlayer sheets, stickers/labels, garbage and similar.

After sorting:

The pallets must be stacked in stacks of 17 wooden pallet in height and sorted into two fractions (NLP quality and Repair) and prepared for shipment to the next customer or return to NLP.
